Getting ready to write: Gathering data	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learn what ‘good data’ looks like for your case study and the importance of objectivity
Getting ready to write: The teaching note/instructors manual	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consider all of the factors that should shape the writing of your teaching note
Writing the case study: Structuring your narrative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Helps you structure your narrative so that it has a clear focus on the dilemma to be discussed by students
Writing the case study: Writing good discussion questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Suggests ways in which you can supply dynamic assignments
Writing the case study: Preparing a teaching plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consider how your case will be delivered practically and how you should support that with a thorough plan
